Senior Launchers Expert at CNES, Michel PONS graduated in France as mechanical engineer (Arts et Métiers Engineering School), obtained a master of Science at Illinois Institute of Technology in Chicago (USA) and worked as research associate at Université de Montréal (Canada, province of Quebec).

He has been working since 1984 at the Launchers Directorate of CNES, the technical center for launchers of the French Space Agency.

He covered different technical and management responsibilities such as mechanical design of turbopumps, reliability of engine and cryotechnical main stage, or leading the French national launchers research program for 10 years.

In 2005 he joined the strategical analysis group for the Director of Launchers, where he particularly deals with innovation, prospective, sustainable design, and creation of cooperative projects.
