He has been involved in field of satellite communications since 1997. Firstly, in private sector, as satcom ground operator's Program manager, he was responsible for the planning and management of satcom projects. In 2004 he moved to government sector by joining Communications Regulatory Authority. His current responsibilities cover the coordination of satellite networks, supervision and protection of national orbital spectrum resources, issue of authorisations to use radio frequencies for satellite services, preparation of regulatory proposals for the provision satcom services on the national and international levels. Presently he is a member of International Telecommunication Union (ITU)

working group on Efficient orbit/spectrum utilization for fixed and broadcasting satellite services, represents Lithuania in European Conference of Postal and Telecommunications Administrations (CEPT) project groups and European Union (EU) expert groups dealing with satellite communication issues, withal was a Lithuania's delegate of World Radiocommunication Conference 2007 (WRC-07). He contributed to the preparation of Lithuanian Space Policy provisions as a member of working group. Mindaugas graduated as a Diploma Engineer (1993) in Electronics Engineering and holds a Bachelor of Engineering from the Kaunas University of Technology and afterward got a Diploma in International Economic Relations from International Business School at Vilnius University (1994).
