

## Saulius Lapienis



Saulius Lapienis studied at Vilnius University, graduated in 1977 as Master of Applied Mathematics. In 1977, started his scientific carrier as junior research fellow at the Institute of Mathematics and Cybernetics. From 1987 until 1990, Saulius Lapienis acted as Head of Applied Science Research Department of the Lithuanian Academy of Sciences. From 1991 until 1993, he was Head of Broker Service Center at the Lithuanian Exchange Ltd. From 1993 until 2004, he acted as co-owner, shareholder and co-Director of several companies in various fields of business. From 2004 until 2006, he was Leader of Systems Development projects at B.G.M. Ltd. From September 2006 until 2011, Saulius Lapienis was Senior specialist at the Agency for International Science and Technology Development Programmes, where he represented Lithuania as NCP in FP7 Space and was a partner of FP7 project COSMOS. Since 2011, Saulius has worked at the Lithuanian Innovation Center as Project consultant. Saulius Lapienis is involved in the activities of the Lithuanian Space Association, he is Director for Development at the Space Science and Technology Institute, deals with Space related issues amongst Lithuanian R&D institutions and SME's, and he is a member of first Lithuanian nanosatellite's creation team.
