Dr. David Korsmeyer is Director of Engineering at NASA Ames Research Center. His responsibilities cover the new mission concepts skunkworks, spacecraft engineering efforts, advanced manufacturing, and spacecraft mission operations at Ames. He began his career at Ames in 1991 supporting advanced software and information technology infusion. He has led many successful engineering projects and served in several senior Program roles. He was the lead of the 'Humans to NEO' mission concepts study for the Constellation Program, and supported the President's 2009 Human Space Flight Review panel on the Flexible Path Architecture for Exploration. He leads the Advanced Exploration Systems work at NASA Ames. Dr. Korsmeyer received his M.S, and Ph.D. in Aerospace Engineering and Astrodynamics from the University of Texas at Austin and is a Sloan Fellow with a Master's in Management from the Stanford Graduate School of Business.
